PROGRAM INFORMATION SHEET

SKI SCHOOL ORIENTATION: Wed, January 6th at Tillicum Middle School, 16020 SE 16th St, Bellevue (on 160th Ave SE). Please note, **all BEGINNER (level 1 or 2) students will meet with their instructor at 6:30 PM** to learn the basics of boarding/skiing. **All STUDENTS will meet at 7:30 PM** for our general orientation. **Attendance at the orientation is REQUIRED** for families new to the ES program, and highly recommended for those who are returning.

EQUIPMENT RENTALS: The Summit rental event will be **Tue Dec 1st 6:30-9:00 PM** at **Highland Middle School** 15027 Bel-Red Rd, Bellevue. Take-home season rentals will be available to our students.

SEASON PASS: The Summit at Snoqualmie will be offering discounted season passes. **Season Passes must be ordered through the Summit by the deadline shown on the Season Pass Application.** Bellevue Ski School will also sell daily lift tickets at the loading zone for \$37 (ages 12 and under). Check (payable to *The Summit*) or exact change only. The cost of a season pass is equivalent to buying ~5 daily tickets.

CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT: Please label all clothing and equipment. Warm clothing and rain gear are essential. A second pair of gloves is a good idea. An approved ski/snowboard helmet is highly recommended (and is required for some classes). Make sure the student's equipment is adjusted and waxed by a qualified technician prior to the start of ski school.

SKI SCHOOL ID CARDS: ID cards will be handed out at the bus loading zone on the first day of ski school. The ID card and BSS shoulder patch must be brought every week to board the bus. There is a \$5 fine for either a missing ID card or shoulder patch.

PROGRAM DATES: Saturdays, Jan 9 – Mar 6. **NOTE: No ski school Feb 13th.**

BUS LOADING: School buses load at **Phantom Lake Elementary School**, 1050 160th Ave SE, Bellevue. Students must be there no later than **8:45 AM**. The buses will leave at **9:00 AM**. All ski school students must ride the bus to the ski area. No exceptions!

LESSONS: Students will be in lessons from 10:30-12:30 PM and from 1:15 to 3:45 PM. Students will be escorted by adult chaperones to and from the buses and when not under the supervision of their instructors.

LUNCH: Students must bring a sack lunch to eat on the bus (they may NOT purchase food at the lodge). No glass containers, please. Please include morning and afternoon pocket snacks.

BUS RETURNS: Students will start to board the buses at 3:30 PM. Buses will leave the Summit at **3:45 PM**. The buses return to Phantom Lake Elementary at approximately 4:35 PM depending on conditions. **PLEASE BE BACK AT PHANTOM LAKE BY 4:45 PM TO PICK UP YOUR STUDENT.**

STUDENT SIGN OUT: If your student is going to leave class early or be picked up at the ski area, **a permission slip must be filled out** and given to the student's bus chaperone **Saturday morning**. ONLY the student's parent or legal guardian may sign the permission slip authorizing themselves or another adult to pick up the student. You can obtain a permission slip from your student's bus chaperone or from our website, <http://www.bellevueskischool.com/forms.php>. At the ski area, the authorized adult must come to the **Summit Central Chaperone Hut no later than 3:30 PM** where **parent/guardian photo ID will be checked before the student is signed out and released.**
